

Welcome to Frontenac Provincial Park

Important Rules/Information for Back Country Campers

1. Permits must be displayed in your vehicle and at your campsite.
2. Camp only at your designated campsite & utilize the privy located at the back of each campsite cluster. Campsites must be vacated by 2 p.m. on the day of permit expiry or on the day you are moving to your next site.
3. All tents must be placed on the designated tent pad.
4. Maximum party size per campsite is 6 persons (4 for youth groups). All persons must be registered on your camping permit.
5. Fires may only be in the designated fire pit & must be extinguished when you leave your site.
6. No cutting of standing trees or shrubs. Only fallen dead wood on the ground may be collected for fires.
7. No carving of picnic table tops or benches.
8. All fireworks & firearms, including air guns and sling shots are prohibited.
9. No excessive noise or abusive language at any time.
10. Alcoholic beverages permitted only on your designated campsite.
11. Clean all fish well away from campsites on the far shore or on an island.
- 12. Dogs must be on a leash 2 meters or less at all times and you must clean up after them. Your pet must not disturb other persons.**
13. You must not leave wildlife attractants (eg. food, garbage) around your campsite. We strongly advise that all food and garbage be hung out of reach of bears and racoons.
14. You must pack out what you pack in. Do not litter or deposit garbage in toilets or fireplaces.
15. Do not bathe with soap or wash dishes directly in the lakes.
16. There is no guarantee that the privies will always have toilet paper. All campers are advised to bring your own supply of toilet paper.
